



Forest Park Junior Berry to Play Soccer at Akron

Dale City, Va. (August 29, 2011) – Autumn Berry, a rising junior at Forest Park High School, has verbally committed to play soccer at the University of Akron in 2013.

Berry, an outside defender, earned all-district honors her first two seasons at Forest Park. This past season she led the team and the Cardinal District in assists. Berry is also a starting defender on the nationally ranked VSA Heat club soccer team and plays varsity basketball at Forest Park.

“Akron is a great school, with great facilities,” said Berry. “The success of the national champion men’s program is contagious, and I can’t wait to get there and help build the same success on the women’s side.”

Entering his fourth season as the head women’s soccer coach at Akron, Chris Pfau continues to elevate the school into one of the top women’s soccer programs in the Mid-American Conference and the entire Midwest. The team claimed a MAC East Division Championship in 2009 and has qualified for back-to-back MAC Tournaments in 2009 and 2010. Akron has dominated the MAC East during the last two seasons, going undefeated against fellow East Division foes in 2009 (5-0-0) and 2010 (4-0-1).
