



## R.E. Lee Junior Cox to Play at James Madison

Springfield (July 8, 2011) - Meghan Cox, a rising junior at R.E. Lee High School, has verbally committed to play soccer at James Madison University in 2013.

Cox, a central defender, earned first team All-District, second team All-Region, and honorable mention All-Met honors this past high school season and was named the team's Most Valuable Player. She is also a starting central defender on the nationally ranked VSA Heat club soccer team and played varsity basketball and field hockey for Lee.

Cox chose JMU however she also considered South Carolina, Virginia and Cincinnati. She joins fellow VSA Heat player Ashley Herndon as one of the Dukes' first two commitments for the 2013 class.

"I really like the atmosphere at JMU," said Cox. "I attended a few camps there, and after talking to the coaches I knew that JMU is where I want to play."

Under head coach Dave Lombardo JMU has consistently finished in the upper tier of the Colonial Athletic Association and is the reigning CAA tournament champion. They have earned a berth in the NCAA women's soccer tournament three of the past four years, including a sweet 16 appearance in 2008.
