



Hanover Senior Davis to Play at Coastal Carolina University

Mechanicsville, Va. (August 8, 2011) – Jordan Davis, a rising senior at Hanover High School, has verbally committed to play soccer at Coastal Carolina University in 2012.

Davis, a midfielder and outside defender, earned All-District and All-Academic honors the past three years and has been named by the Richmond, Va. media as a “Regional Player to Watch.” She ranks in the top five all time in Hanover history for scoring, assists and points. She is also a midfielder on the nationally ranked VSA Heat club soccer team and competes in varsity track for Hanover.

Davis also considered Winthrop, Highpoint, Bryant and George Washington before choosing Coastal Carolina.

“Coach Hogan and coach Stoneman really sold me on Coastal’s program,” said Davis. “Once I visited the campus I just knew it was a great fit for me.”

Coastal Carolina has been picked to finish in the top four in the Big South Conference in a 2011 pre-season poll of conference coaches. Under first year head coach Paul Hogan and assistant coach Rich Stoneman the Chanticleers are returning 15 players from last season’s regular season championship team and are welcoming 15 new players. Hogan joins Coastal Carolina following a ten-year stint at the University of Colorado, including the last five as associate head coach.
