



Heat Girls Garner High School Honors

HAYMARKET, Va., June 22, 2011 -- The VSA Heat Blue, a nationally-ranked club soccer team, is making a big impact on the metropolitan area high school scene. All 16 Heat players started for 13 different high school varsity teams, one at keeper, five on defense, four in the midfield, and six at forward.

This past high school year the players collectively tallied 146 goals, dished out 101 assists, and recorded 50 saves. Five players led their teams in goals scored and five players led their teams in assists. Four players were named team Most Valuable Player.

Of the two juniors and 14 sophomores on the Heat, 14 earned All-District honors in their respective leagues, with eight also being selected for All-Region recognition, and two named to Virginia All-State teams. In addition, six players were named to the prestigious Washington Post All-Met team.



“These girls have all worked hard to get where they are, sacrificing a lot to reach the highest level,” said Steve Smith, VSA Heat Blue head coach. “It is great to see them succeed in front of their high school friends. The memories they gather in high school will stay with them forever.”
